Day 1

Arrival to Egypt and Dinner Cruise

When you arrive at Cairo airport, the representative of Best Destination Tours will meet you at the airport then you will be transferred by a private A/C car to check in at the 5* hotel.

Evening time you will enjoy a dinner cruise accompanied by your tour guide: Sit back and relax while you enjoy a colorful belly dancing show with a folklore band, featuring the unforgettable tannoura spin, in keeping with Egypt's whirling dervishes tradition, then you will be transferred back to your hotel.

Day 2

Giza Pyramids Tour

After breakfast, start the exploration of the 9-day Egypt tour by joining your private Egyptologist tour guide to visit the ancient Egypt civilization in Giza Pyramids Complex one of the 7 Wonders of the World: The complex includes three main pyramids, six little pyramids, the great sphinx and the Valley Temple. The complex dates back to the 4th dynasty 2400 years B.C. The Great Pyramid belongs to King Khufu which is the oldest and largest of the three pyramids of Giza plateau and the only one to remain intact from the 7 Wonders of the Ancient World. The Great Sphinx belongs to King Chephren. It is the oldest known monumental sculpture. A Granite mortuary temple was used by Ancient Egyptians for the mummification process and this is the only remaining one at the Giza plateau. Proceed to have your lunch at a local restaurant in Cairo.

Then move to visit the first true Pyramid that was built during the ancient Egypt era:- It is considered to be the earliest large-scale cut stone construction; it dates back to the reign of King Djoser who ruled Egypt during the 27th century B.C.

Then move to visit:- The 1st capital all over Egypt founded by King Menes, It occupied a strategic position between Upper & Lower Egypt. Memphis was believed to be under the

protection of the god Ptah, the god of creation and artworks.

Finally, we drive you back to your hotel in Cairo overnight.

Day 3

Visit Old Cairo Landmarks

After breakfast, you will join your private tour guide to continue your trip by visiting Cairo tourist attractions: the Egyptian Museum displays a rare collection of 5000 years of art. Over 250,000 genuine artifacts are presented, including an exhibit dedicated to Tutankhamun's collection of treasure, gold, and jewelry which was enclosed in his tomb for over 3,500 years. Lunch will be served at a local restaurant in Cairo then proceed to visit:- It served as Egypt's seat of government till the 1860s, Cairo Citadel is a magnificent fortress. It was constructed during Salah ad-Din's reign. The construction work started in 1176 and was completed in 1182.

Then move to visit:- It was constructed between 1830 and 1848, the mosque was named "The Alabaster Mosque" because most of the walls were made out of pure alabaster. The mosque is a replica of the Blue Mosque in Istanbul. Continue your tour by visiting:- No visit to Cairo is Complete without a stop at the Khan El-Khalili bazaar, the bazaar is the oldest and the most famous in the Middle East. It was constructed in 970 AD, the same year as the founding of Cairo. At the end of the day, we will transfer you back to your hotel overnight.

Day 4

Alexandria Tour

Take a fascinating private tour to Alexandria joining your private Egyptologist guide to continue your Alexandria, Cairo & Sharm El Sheikh holiday by exploring the most famous

Alexandria tourist attractions starting with: - A Roman burial site whose family tomb reveals the merging of Egyptian and Roman art and architecture. Descend below ground to visit the tomb and Caracalla Hall. Back above ground, continue to visit: - An 82-foot (25-meter) granite column built to honor Emperor Diocletian, who freed the besieged city and brought food to its starving people. Continuing to visit: A 15th-century fortress located on the Mediterranean Sea coast. It was established in 1477 AD by Sultan Al-Ashraf Qa'it Bay. Qaitbay Citadel is situated in the same place as Pharos Island Lunch will be served at a seafood restaurant, and after that complete your journey by visiting to: - A copy of every book published in the world is kept in the library, making it one of the great literary sites in the world. Alexandria Library also houses several exhibitions relating to the history of Egypt and a display of rare antique books.
