Day 1

Start of Your Dahabiya

Arrival at Luxor Airport, Best Destination Tours will meet and assist you with our representative. We visit Karnak Temple & Luxor Temple,

and then we will be transferred to Esna to board the <u>Dahabiya Nile</u> <u>cruise</u>. The crew welcomes you on board and will have your bags taken into your cabins. We will then set sail on our voyage to Aswan. We stay overnight close to El-Hegz Island, a small island located in the north of Edfu.

Day 2

Day Tour in Edfu

Morning Sailing gently en-route to Edfu; we enjoy breakfast at your leisure; and visit Edfu Temple, one of the largest and most intact of Egypt's monuments, with two beautiful granite statues of the Falcon God Horus flank the entrance, by horse carriage. After we visit the temple, we either ride or walk through the bazaar; this is an extensive bazaar where you can barter for souvenirs, spices, and perfumes. We will then set sail for our private island "El-Fouza" where we will disembark for dinner served to you on the edge of the Nile.

Day 3

Free Day in Nebyt Dahabiya

We start our nice day by sailing around 7 hours to El-Silsila Mountain aboard the luxury Dahabiya Nile cruise. During our sailing, we experienced the simple lifestyle of farmers and fishermen.

Lastly, we are going to enjoy our last night trip with our Nubian party, and along the way, you'll have the opportunity to see some of the most famous tourist places in Aswan.

Explore Famous Sites of Aswan

We sail to Aswan, exploring the famous city, an amazing tour on the 6-Day Nebyt dahabiya nile cruise includes a visit to the <u>High Dam</u> and the <u>Unfinished Obelisk</u>, a motorboat ride to the <u>Temple of Philae</u>, and <u>Botanical Gardens</u>, enjoying its fragrance and a variety of bird life before taking another felucca sail back to Aswan.
